SYMBOL IN THE WINDOW: On this day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descends from heaven with a sound like the rush of violent wind. On the New Testament side, the second panel from the right see seven lamps: The oldest symbol of the Holy Spirit which signifies the seven gifts of the Spirit, and which tell of the seven churches to which the letters were written in the Book of Revelation. This symbol is below the descending dove which is another symbol of the Holy Spirit.
